

Pangburn Park (442 S Tanglewood Rd, Versailles IN 47042) Play baseball, basketball, and on the play-set!

• How many box-style steps does it take to get to the top of the climbing platform?

Sersailles Sports Complex (1776 S Co Rd 50 W, Versailles, IN 47042) Enjoy the accessible park which includes a hiking trail, playground, little free library, and pavilions. Baseball and soccer fields for recreation league only.

• What is the name of the soccer field?

Skevin Hensley Memorial Park (128 N Main Street, Versailles, IN 47042) Murals border the park, which boasts a splash pad, pergola with swings, musical play instruments, benches and Ride & Share bikes. On select dates during the summer, enjoy live music at the Holdsworth Entertainment Pavilion.

• What monument tops the Never Forget Garden marker?

Versailles State Park (1387 US-50, Versailles, IN 47042) Enjoy the mountain bike trails, hiking trails, lake, shelter houses, kayaking, swimming, camping, and numerous playgrounds at the park.

• What is the Environmental license plate number located at the front gate?

Busching Bridge Trail (Trailhead at 1 Water Park Street, Versailles, IN) - This trail is open for hiking, biking, and walking trail and is part of the Next Level Trails program. The trail is a 1/2 mile trail and then 3/10 of mile on the road to the covered bridge.

• Name 3 Versailles Mountain Bike Trails named after living things:

Bradt Nature Area (1004 U.S. 50, Versailles, 47042) Go for a hike and observe wildlife. The nature area includes a small woodland, open meadows, and a constructed wetland complete with an observation deck.

• What year did the Bradt family donate the property to Versailles State Park?

Holton Community Park (6803 W Versailles St Holton, IN 47023) Enjoy a game of basketball, playing on the playground, or host an outdoor party under the shelters.

How many picnic tables are in the park shelter?

Osgood Trails (2067 W County Rd 300 N, Osgood, IN 47037) Enjoy the accessible paved trails. Includes fishing pier, walking trails, outdoor exercise equipment and is bike and pet friendly. Keep an eye out for one of several bald eagles who make the trails their home. Be sure and read the Story-walk!

What might you spot eagles doing at the park?

The Osgood Sculpture (127 North Buckeye St., Osgood, IN 47037) at the Osgood Lions Mini Park. The Osgood Sculpture is an interactive sculpture made by local company Iron Timbers using teakwood and hammered copper. Relax and check out "Ozzy" the Bicentennial Bison and the mural by Robert Dafford.

• Besides Ozzy, where are the four other bison at the park?

Daren Baker Memorial Park (525 Thompson Lane, Milan IN 47031) Enjoy the shelter, baseball fields, accessible swing, playground, paved walking trail, and lake. Be sure and read the Story-walk!

• How many benches can you find at the park?

Sunman Community Park (225 Fitch Ave, Sunman, IN 47041) Play on the play set, baseball fields, enjoy a nice picnic at one of three shelters, and read a book out of the little free library. Be sure and read the Story-walk!

• Who provides Wi-fi to the park?

Weberding Park (Dirks Road, between Highway 46 and Lammers Pike in Batesville) Play on the playground, have a picnic in the shelter area on the picnic tables.

• How many swings can you find at Weberding Park?

YMCA Community Sports Complex (30 State Road 129S, Batesville, IN 47006) This outdoor area next to the YMCA has a beautiful pavilion, four pickleball courts, and two basketball courts. The outdoor complex is open to the public and can be accessed via walking trails or you may park next to the courts in the YMCA parking lot.

• Can non-serving player/team score points in a pickleball game?

Batesville/YMCA Walking Trail (Near the corner of Coonhunters Road [N County Road 300 E] and Polhman Street) This trail connects to the YMCA Outdoor Sports Complex and has benches along the way.
